EXPLORE CAMBODIA MISSION TEAM

Cambodia is a land of beauty and ancient history which is still suffering the effects of the horrific Khmer Rouge regime in the 1970s. In the midst of the darkness and brokenness, Jesus' light is shining bright through cross-cultural mission workers and Cambodian Christians.

Join our Explore Cambodia mission team and you will connect with Gateway Beyond workers **Tristan and Megan Crilley**, visit **Bloom** and other ministries, visit community development projects delivering clean water solutions in rural Cambodia, meet with Cambodian Christians, and get your hands a bit dirty making some **water filters** in villages. We will visit the capital city of Phnom Penh, the city of Siem Reap and spend **a night in a village** surrounded by rice fields.

You'll see and learn lots, unpack issues such as poverty and injustice, and have challenging and insightful conversations as you ride on bumpy and dusty roads, sit on the floor to eat, and shop at local markets. The team will visit the **ancient wonders of Angkor Wat** temples and maybe even have the chance to eat a deep-fried tarantula!

This is an Explore mission team. You will have some opportunities to practically help and minister however our focus is to go with an **attitude to learn** from the people we visit.

MAKE IT YOUR MISSION TO GO

WHEN: 1-9 December 2018 (approx. dates).
Applications close 31 May 2018.

HOW MUCH: Approximately \$3,000-\$3,500 including flights and in-country costs (accommodation, food, transport). Insurance is provided for regular Gateway attenders. Vaccinations, passports and visas are an additional cost.

TEAM: Max. 14 people. The team will be selected through an application process. We will consider applications from teens in Year 10, 11 or 12 accompanied by a parent.

TRAINING: You will need to attend six to eight 2 hour training meetings prior to departure and also a debrief meeting after you return.
